

Ruth Marie Hassler-Obituary

Funeral services for Ruth Marie Hassler, 51, were held Thursday, November 21, 2002, at 2:00 p.m. at the Assembly of God Church, in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Dwight Dean and Pastor Gregory Huffer officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mrs. Hassler died Sunday, November 17, 2002, at Poudre Valley Hospital at Fort Collins, Colorado.

Ruth was born September 30, 1951, in Red Cloud, Nebraska, the daughter of Christopher Wilroy and Charldean Fern (Holloway) Livers. She lived in the Nebraska communities of Red Cloud, Superior, and Stapleton and Wheatland, Wyoming. She graduated from Wheatland High School in 1969; attended Southwestern Assembly of God Bible College in Waxahachie, Texas, for a year; and also attended Eastern Wyoming College in Torrington, Wyoming. Ruth loved music and blessed many with her musical talents. She loved to read, had a knack for setting a nice table, and cooking a good meal for company. She married Elmer Hassler on June 10, 1973, in Wheatland. Ruth and her husband pastured churches in Wyoming at Greybull, Worland, Shirley Basin, and Wheatland, as well as one in Minatare, Nebraska.

Ruth is survived by her husband, Elmer of Wheatland; three children, John Hassler and wife, Lynette of Jackson, Wyoming, Tiffany and Brittany Hassler both of Wheatland; four brothers, Glenn Livers of Lincoln, Nebraska, John Livers of Cheyenne, Wyoming, and James Livers and Kent Livers both of Wheatland; and two grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her father, Christopher W. Livers on October 23, 1980, and her mother, Charldean F. Livers on August 10, 2002. Serving as pallbearers were Gary Hassler, Larry Hassler, Greg Hassler, Tim Livers, Carl Conway, and Jack Fisk.
