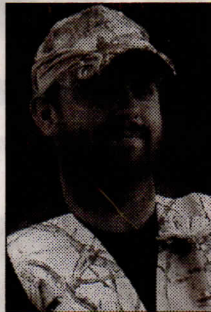
Jason Havard passed away Monday, March 19, 2018 at the Memorial Hospital of Converse County as a result of a motor vehicle accident.

After graduation he attended Casper College for two years where he received a diesel mechanic certificate. He worked as a truck driver in the oil and drilling industry.

When Poorboy was getting introduced to someone new, his famous line was "My name is Apadaca Darwin Dunlap but you can just call me A.D.D. on the account that my mother says that I have A.D.D."
