Dana A. Havely, a former resident of the community, passed away at Mesa, Arizona, April 1, after a short illness. Funeral services will be held from the Schrader Chapel in Wheatland, Saturday, April 6th, at 10:30 a.m. and interment will be in the local cemetery. Nephews of Mr. Havely will serve as pallbearers.
