

HAVELY, LAURA JANE MCCONNELL

December 28, 1868-December 8, 1935

Mrs. H.D. Havely, resident of the Slater community for the past 23 years, passed away Sunday after an illness of about eight months, at the age of 66 years.

Funeral services were held from the Copley Funeral Chapel Tuesday afternoon at 1:30, with Rev. Anderson of Albin, in charge. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery.

Louie Jane McConnell was born at Grand River, Decatur county, Iowa on December 28, 1868 and departed this life at Wheatland December 8<sup>th</sup>, 1935 at 12:06, aged 66 years, 11 months and 10 days.

She grew to womanhood at Mount Ayr, Ringgold County, Iowa, and was married to Henry Dea Havely in this community to which union was born twelve children.

Surviving Mrs. Havely are her husband and ten children: Mrs. J.E. Senevey and Otis Havely of Lingle; Mrs. C.M. Searl of Laramie; Ora and Mark of Wheatland; Herbert, Dana, Lula and Seigel of Slater; and Worley of Manderson. Two sons passed on in infancy. She also leaves twelve grandchildren and four brothers and two sisters, Mrs. N.H. Richardson and Don McConnell of Lingle; Mrs. P.F. Conant of Benedict, Nebr. and Harl, Fred and Bird McConnell of Beaconsfield, Iowa.

Mrs. Havely was a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, having been baptized into this church at Olean, Nebr. June 18, 1905.
