

Mark Havely, 76, dies here

W. Mark Havely, passed away Saturday, Dec. 8, 1979, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 76.

Mark Havely was born at Burwell, Neb. June 8, 1903. At the age of nine he moved with his family to a homestead East of Slater, where he lived until 1933. He then moved to Wheatland and was employed for 12 years at the Blow Oil Co.

On December 30, 1933, he married Grace Sedman. After farming East of Wheatland for
