December 24, 1934 in Casper, Wyoming the daughter of John and Lela (Schram) Clare.

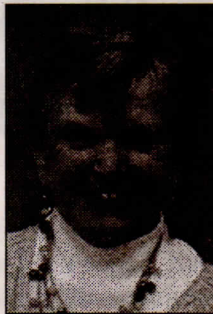
The family moved from Casper to Worland, Wyoming where she graduated high school and then went on to Creighton University in Omaha,
