For Ray Hegglund To Be On Thursday

Funeral services will be held Thursday, October 9, 1975, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home at 2:00 p.m. for Ray Hegglund. Rev. Delbert Dick will officiate at the services. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Hegglund passed away Monday, October 6, 1975 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 73. A retired mechanic, he had lived in Wheatland since 1929. He was born in Gothenburg, Nebraska September 25, 1902. Before coming to Wheatland he had made his home in Glendo and Slater. He married Florence Miller in Wheatland on June 30, 1941. A member of the Protestant faith Mr. Hegglund served actively with the Volunteer Fire Department for 32 years.

In death he is survived by his wife, Florence; one son, Charles of Wheatland; one daughter, Alice Lamb of Cody; two sisters, Sue Hegglund of Fraser Park, California and Grace Hegglund of Portland, Oregon and six grandchildren. One brother, Lee preceded him in death June, 1975.
