A funeral service for Katie Alice Henderscheid, 24, was held at 11 a.m. Tuesday, Feb. 18 at the Memorial Baptist Church in Wheatland with Pastor Craig Cagle officiating. Burial will take place at a later date.

Katie Henderscheid passed away Thursday, Feb. 13 at her home near Wheatland. Katie was born on Jan. 5, 1990 in Wheatland, the daughter of Dan and Danette (Donovan) Henderscheid. She was the second of four children and a resident of Wheatland since birth. Katie was homeschooled and achieved all three Congressional Award Certificates and Medals.

She was employed by Basin Electric at Laramie River Station as an assistant plant operator at the time of her death. She talked highly of many of her co-workers. Before Basin, she was employed at Common Cents as a manager. She was an avid horsewoman and hunter. She could out man anyone around, even John Wayne, and often proved that to be true. She liked to spend time in the mountains surrounding the area with her fiancé Josh Evans. They were planning to be married in October.

Katie was always upbeat and ready for anything; she often brought home bull snakes, her wild pet of choice. Along with her wild critters, she always had two or three... or four dogs following her around. She was fearless (except for

spiders and June bugs) and wild like the mountain winds, beautiful inside and out. Katie loved her family, especially her niece, Rona.
