Funeral liturgy for Joseph Leo Hermann, 17, was conducted at 2:00 P.M. Friday, April 30, 2004, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Monsignor Gene Sullivan as the celebrant. The Vigil for the Deceased was at 7:00 P.M. on Thursday, April 29, 2004, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland.

Joseph died Monday, April 26, 2004, at United Medical Center - West in Cheyenne, Wyoming, from injuries sustained in a vehicular accident near Wheatland.

He was born February 28, 1987, in Wheatland, the son of Thomas F. and Celia (Kernan) Hermann. He was reared and educated in Wheatland and was a sophomore at Wheatland High School at the time of his death. He was involved in 4-H, shooting sports, and was a member of the Catholic Youth Group at Saint Patrick Catholic Church. He also enjoyed hunting, fishing, and welding.

Joseph is survived by his parents, Tom and Celia Hermann of Wheatland; a sister, Tina and husband, Robert Woolsey of Douglas, Wyoming; brother, Mike Hermann of Wheatland; and paternal grandmother, Margaret Hermann of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Rachel Hermann on August 15, 2000; maternal grandparents, Leo Kernan on June 11, 1993 and Katherine Kernan on March 29, 1981; and paternal grandfather, Kenneth Hermann on February 11, 2002.
