August 20, 1916 – May 17, 2006

Graveside services and interment for Margaret J. Hermann, 89, were conducted at 2 p.m., Monday, May 22 in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland, with Pastor Andy Gudahl of the First Christian Church officiating.

She died Wednesday, May 17, 2006, at Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Margaret was born Aug. 20, 1916, in Meriden, Wyo., the daughter of Rachel (Dunn) and David Stevens. She was reared and educated in the Meriden area. Margaret married Kenneth F.
