

HERNDON, SAMUEL WARREN  
December 18, 1857-February 13, 1945

Last rites will be held for Samuel Warren Herndon, 87, in the Schrader chapel at 2:30 p.m. Friday with the Rev. W.J. Lasher officiating, and burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery. Six of the grandchildren will act as pallbearers.

Mr. Herndon, who is a retired produce dealer, died in the Wheatland hospital Tuesday, February 13, where he had been confined since November 3 with a hip injury. He was born December 1857 in Ripley county, Ind. and had been a resident of this county for the past ten years. His wife died 38 years ago.
