

John William "Bill" Herring

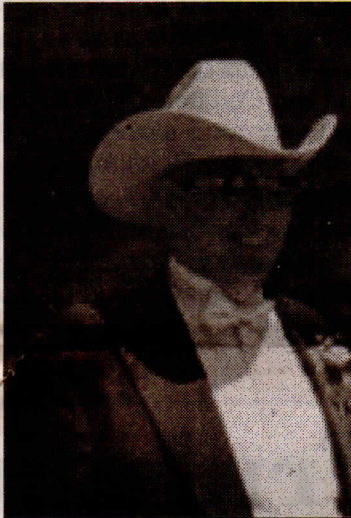
March 1, 1941 - May 9, 2017
