

HESSELTINE, FREDERICK O.
March 6, 1867-December 24, 1939

Frederick O. Hesselstine, 72, resident of the Wheatland community for many years, passed away Sunday morning, December 24. Mr. Hesselstine was born in Washington, Iowa, March 6, 1867, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Franklin Hesselstine, and one of a family of ten children, all but three of them have preceded him in death.

He was united in marriage to Miss Sarah Bartlett in Centerville, Iowa, and to them were born three children, two sons and one daughter. Of these, one son, Forrest, preceded him in death. Ferry and Mrs. Fern Curtis reside here. Besides his widow and two children he is survived by four granddaughters, six grandsons, all of Wheatland, a brother of Des Moines, Iowa and one of Port Gamble, Washington, and a sister, Mrs. Guy Tracy of Walnut City, Iowa. He was a member of the Church of Christ.

The Hesselstine family moved to Wheatland in 1919 and for a time, Mr. Hesselstine was section foreman. Of late years, he held a position with the city until failing health prevented active labor.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon in the Christian church with the Rev. H.N. Waddell officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with Watson and Dennis in charge.
