

Bonnie V. Hiatt

Bonnie V. Hiatt, 78, of Laramie, died Monday May 9, 1994 at Ivinson Memorial Hospital.

She was born July 23, 1915 in Appanose County, Iowa, daughter of Douglas Curtis and Gail (Hiatt) Burton. She attended public schools in Iowa, graduating from High School there. She taught school in Iowa after graduation, until she was married to Preston Hiatt on June 30, 1935.

Together Preston and Bonnie moved to Wheatland, where they farmed and ranched for many years. They moved to Saratoga, where they were semi-retired. Mr. Hiatt died in 1984 and Mrs. Hiatt moved to Laramie to be near her family.

She was an active member of the Methodist Church and also the Laramie Senior Center.
