

HIRSCHY, PETER SR.
1856-1922

Peter Hirschy, a well known farmer whose home was two miles west of Bordeaux, died on Monday. He was taken ill on Nov. 24th, and on the following Tuesday came to Wheatland and entered Dr. Smith's office for treatment. His illness was pronounced pneumonia and he steadily failed until death came to his relief.

Mr. Hirschy was born in Indiana in 1856. In 1878 he was married to Susanna Bandy at Lima, Ohio. To this union, twelve children were born, only two of whom, Peter Hirschy and Mrs. Phoebe Howard, are living in this part of the country, and were present at the funeral. The others are living in distant states. Mrs. Hirschy passed away four years ago. Funeral services were held from the Methodist church Tuesday afternoon, Rev. R.F. Paxton officiating.

The deceased had resided at Bordeaux since 1914 and was a highly respected citizen of the county.
