

Myrtle B. Hobson

WHEATLAND — Services for Myrtle B. Hobson, 83, who died Feb. 20, 1987 in Canyon City, Colo., will be Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. at the Wheatland Methodist Church, with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

She was born Oct. 9, 1903 near Wheatland to Bill and Cora Johnson. In 1906, the family moved to a homestead near Glen, Neb., returning to Wheatland in 1920. She was a 1923 graduate of Wheatland High School and attended summer school at the University of Wyoming. She later taught school in the Antelope Gap and Slater areas.

She married Harold Hobson in Gering, Neb. June 30, 1926. For several years, they lived in the Antelope Gap area. In 1938 they moved to the Slater area and in 1943 to Wheatland. They had celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary last June.

Mrs. Hobson was active in the church and in the Banner Rebekah Lodge #16 which she joined in 1935. She received her 50-year pin in 1985 and held many offices in the lodge. She was secretary for the past 25 years and in 1985 was the chaperone on the United National Pilgrimage Tour.

She is survived by her husband, Harold, of Wheatland.

A memorial has been established to the Rebekah and Oddfellows Lodges. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. The Schrader-Prell Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
