

HOBSON, NORA MAY BELL
December 13, 1875-February 24, 1938

Nora May Bell was born near Ft. Wayne, Indiana, December 13, 1875 and departed this life on February 24, 1938 at the home of her sister-in-law at Tulsa, Oklahoma, being 62 years, 2 months and 11 days of age.

She spent her girlhood days in eastern Iowa. She was united to the church at Fort Madison, Iowa in 1893,

On moving to Kansas, she joined the Friends church of which she remained a member.

She was united in marriage to Wendell Hobson at Independence, Kansas, Dec. 26, 1895, where they resided until March 1909 when they moved to Wheatland, Wyo., making this their home for the past 29 years.

To this union were born four children, Mrs. John W. Anderson, Harold, Wendell, Jr., and Warren, all of Wheatland.

She is survived by her husband, four children and one grandson, two sisters, Mrs. Arthur E. Larson of Davenport, Ia., and Mrs. Geo. Mitchell of San Diego, Calif., and a host of friends.

She was a loyal wife and mother, always active in the social work of her community.
