Donald (Roy) Hoffman, 65, died March 25, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home.

Roy was born in Iowa, Aug. 26, 1915 and came with his family to homestead in the Little Bear area in 1921. In 1925 he moved to the Wheatland Flats and in 1935 relocated to Bordeaux. On Dec. 11, 1943, he married Eura Lee (Pat) Patton and the couple moved to Wheatland in 1945. Roy was associated with various construction projects around Wyoming and northern Colorado.

He was a member of the Wheatland Lodge No. 16 AF and AM since 1941 and was also a member of operating Engineers No. 400.

He is survived by his wife Pat, of Wheatland, two sons, Richard Hoffman of Wheatland and William Musselman of California; a daughter, Joyce Miller of Sheridan.
