

HOFFMAN, EARL F.
February 16, 1886-October 28, 1916

Earl F. Hoffman, who had been ill for many months past, was laid away to his last long rest on Sunday afternoon. Having resided in this vicinity for the greater part of the 30 years of his life, he was widely known and his high character won him the warm regard of a large circle of friends. The funeral was largely attended friends from all directions coming from 40 miles around to pay their final respects to his memory. The funeral was held from the Congregational church, being conducted by Rev. W.L. Wade of the M.E. church of which the deceased was a faithful and a consistent member. Deceased was the son of Mr. and Mrs. A.L. Hoffman. He was born Feb. 16, 1886. In 1913, he was united in marriage to Miss Ursula Schmidt, the wife who survives him.
