

HOFFMAN, EOLINE FANNIE HUDSON

November 23, 1882-May 27, 1977

Services were held Tuesday, May 31, for Eoline Fannie Hoffman, 94, at the Methodist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Delbert Dick officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. She died Friday, May 27, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after an extended illness.

She was born at Wauneta, Nebraska, November 23, 1882. She came to Wheatland area as a young girl with her family where they homesteaded. She married Albert Hoffman December 6, 1909 at Cheyenne.

She was a 50 year member of OES, a past matron of Eastern Star and also belonged to the Rebecca Lodge.

In death she is survived by two sons, Donald of Spencer, Iowa and Harold of Wheatland; one daughter, Marie Grayson of Vicksburg, Miss.; two brothers, Everett Hudson of Boulder, Colo., and Claud Hudson of Lakeview, Wash.; three sisters, Crystal Adams, Longmont, Colo., Effie Loughmiller of Cheyenne, and Hyacinth McCracken of Longmont, Colo.; nine grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Albert, one brother and three sisters.
