October 6, 1892-November 14, 1961

Funeral services were held today (Friday) for Mrs. Inez Mae Hoffman, wife of Cecil L. Hoffman of Wheatland. She passed away at the Platte County Memorial hospital on Tuesday, November 14, after a long illness.

Mrs. Hoffman was born in Taylor County, Ia., October 6, 1892. She came from Iowa to Little Bear, Wyo. In 1920, and in 1929, moved to Platte county, residing for many years in the Bordeaux community.
