

Edward George 'Ed' Hogan

February 16, 1940 - August 12, 2005

Funeral liturgy for Edward George "Ed" Hogan, 65, will be conducted at 11 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 18, 2005, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church, 1009 - 9th Street in Wheatland, with Father Jan Santich officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland. Vigil for the Deceased will be conducted at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 17, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church.

He died Friday, Aug. 12 at his home near Wheatland.

Ed was born Feb. 16, 1940, in Louisville, Colo., the son of Margaret Mary (Kasenga) and Edward Joseph Hogan. He first attended elementary school in a one-room schoolhouse at Eldorado Springs, Colo.; middle school at Sacred Heart in Boulder, Colo.; and graduated in 1958 from Arvada Senior High School. He was employed in drywall construction in Sheridan; then he and his brother operated Hogan Brothers Drywall in Boulder. Ed returned to Colorado in 1983 to the Hogan family ranch at Rocky Flats. He retired in 2000 and moved to a ranch outside of Wheatland where they raised ponies. He was a member of the Moose Lodge and enjoyed games of competition in all sports includ-

ing basketball, softball, billiards, and horseshoes and all outdoor activities. When his children were younger, he coached girl's softball and was a 4-H leader in Boulder County. He enjoyed watching his children in all of their sports activities.

Survivors include his wife, Robyn of Wheatland; five children, Penny Kinsinger of Sheridan, Patricia Hogan of Thornton, Colo., Ronald Hogan of Wheatland, Brian Hogan of San Diego, Calif., and Phillip and wife, Emily of Westminster, Colo.; a brother, William Hogan of Boulder; sister, Joann Bergquist of Fraser, Colo.; two grandchildren, Britanny Buszkewic and Jeremi Buszkewic and wife, Alisha all of Sheridan; and two great grandsons, Blaine and Paison Buszkewic of Sheridan.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
