

HOLCOMB, JAMES HOWARD
September 21, 1909-September 16, 1913

James Howard Holcomb, the four-year-old son of Mr. And Mrs. William Holcomb, who reside five miles west of town, died at the Wheatland sanatorium on Tuesday, Sept. 16, of gangrene of the intestines, following acute appendicitis. The child had been sick about a week and on Tuesday was taken to the sanatorium and an operation was performed in a last effort to save his life but it was too late to check the dreaded disease.

Funeral services conducted by Rev. J.R. Hicks were held from the Fred Belcher home in Wheatland yesterday afternoon and the body interred in the Wheatland cemetery.
