

HOOLEY, IVAN STANLEY
July 23, 1898-May 22, 1978

Funeral services will be held for Ivan Stanley Hooley, Friday, May 26, 1978 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church with Delbert Dick officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Hooley passed away in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Monday, May 22, 1978 after a brief illness. He was 79.

Ivan Hooley was born in Woodland, Illinois July 23, 1898. He came to Cassa, Wyoming at the age of 15. He worked for awhile with the CB & Q Railroad and homesteaded in the Cassa Community. He entered the Marine Corps during World War I. After discharge from the military, he returned to his homestead in Cassa.

He married Nellie Thurman April 21, 1923 in Wheatland, and they remained on the Cassa ranch until his retirement to Wheatland in November of 1977.

Hooley is survived by his wife Nellie of Wheatland; three sons, Stanley and Kenneth of Wheatland, and Quentin of Torrington; and three grandchildren.
