

HOPWOOD, ALONZO LITTELL SR.  
August 6, 1888-November 11, 1976

Funeral services for Alonzo L. Hopwood, Sr. were held Tuesday, November 16, 1976 at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home with Rev. Elliott Graves officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mr. Hopwood passed away at the age of 88 at his home in Olympia, Washington Thursday, November 11, 1976.

A Wheatland area resident for 60 years, Mr. Hopwood was born in Vinton, Iowa, August 6, 1888. He was married to Clara E. Greff. While in this area he farmed and ranched in the Chugwater region. He also maintained an optometry practice in Wheatland. He moved to Olympia, Washington after the death of his wife, Clara, in 1972.

Mr. Hopwood served his country during World War I as a member of the U.S. Army. He was a member of the Chugwater Methodist Church and the Masonic Lodge. In death he is survived by his son, Alonzo L. Hopwood, Jr., and three grandchildren.
