

HOWARD, JOHN M.

November 8, 1920-November 18, 1946

Mr. and Mrs. W.C. Howard were notified recently by the Quartermaster General's department that their son, Capt. John M. Howard, that interment have been accomplished with fitting dignity and solemnity at the U.S. Military Cemetery "Mirandola". The cemetery is located 18 miles northeast of Modena, Italy.

Captain Howard, known so well to his many friends as Jack, was reported missing in action on Nov. 18, 1944. On November 19, 1945, he was officially declared as killed in action. With this letter was the first actual information as to his being killed or his burial. Jack, at the time of his death, was pilot of a night fighter over Italy and went down with his plane and his radar operator on board.
