

W. C. Howard dies suddenly at home

William Creamer Howard, 85, passed away April 14 at his home following a sudden illness. Born in Cresco, Ia., Feb. 1, 1877, he had resided in Wheatland since 1929, and was a prominent farmer on the South Flats. The family resided in Montana before coming to Wheatland. Mr. Howard was a member of the Catholic church and was a third degree Knights of Columbus.

Funeral services were held at St. Patrick church in Wheatland on Tuesday morning of this week at ten o'clock, Father Leonard Wren the officiating minister. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Rosary services were held Monday evening at 7:30 at Schrader Chapel.
