

HOWE, KENNETH VALENTINE

February 14, 1886-May 12, 1950

Funeral services for a well-known grocery owner, Kenneth Valentine Howe, were held at the Congregational church with the Rev. W. James Hoare in charge.

He died suddenly at his home after being confined in the Veteran's hospital in Cheyenne. Howe had operated the grocery store on the Laramie cut-off for 15 years. Born February 14, 1886, Bedford, Ia., he had been a member of the IOOF lodge for the past 25 years.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Nettie Howe; two sons, Floyd Howe and Harold Howe, both of Cheyenne; two brothers, Roy Howe of Torrington and John Howe of Illinois; one sister, Mrs. Floyd Benson of Long Beach, Calif., and two grandchildren.

Burial took place at the local cemetery with the Odd Fellows services given at the graveside. The pallbearers were Roger Mills, Carl West, Ezra Davis, Harold Hobson, Ray Howard and Wallace Baker.
