

HOWELL, MARY ELIZABETH BOWEN

January 7, 1868-October 20, 1926

Mrs. Marion Howell passed away at her home Wednesday evening, October 20, after a long period of ill health, and was buried at the Wheatland cemetery Saturday.

She was born at La Plata, Mo., January 7, 1868, her maiden name having been Mary Elizabeth Bowen. After growing to womanhood, she was married to Marion W. Howell, and they moved to Macon, Mo., and then to Kearney, Mo. From there, she moved with her family to Wheatland, Wyo., where she lived until her death.

At the age of 20, she became a member of the Christian church, and was always known as an example of sincere Christianity. Lately, owing to ill health, she had not been able to leave her home to any extent but, nevertheless, was always willing to assist her friends as far as her strength permitted.
