

HOWELL, NANCY

?-January 22, 1914

Mrs. Nannie Howell dropped dead from heart failure at her homestead near Coney Hills about 20 miles southwest of Wheatland Thursday afternoon about one o'clock. She has suffered from heart trouble for a number of years, but at no time was her condition considered serious. She had not complained of feeling any worse than usual and her sudden death was a shock to all. Her age was 53 years, 2 months and 25 days.

She and her three smaller children were at home alone, and she was working in the yard when death occurred.

She is survived by her nine children: Mrs. Harmon of Liberty, Mo.; Frank Howell of Huntsville, Mo.; Charles Howell of Sunrise, Wyo.; Samuel, Carl, Riley, Wendell, Lester and Chester of Wheatland, the three last named were with her when death came. The husband, William Howell, preceded her to the grave seven years ago.

Funeral services will be held from the Christian church in Wheatland Sunday afternoon and interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
