

HOWELL, SAMUEL E.  
March 28, 1860-January 19, 1947

Samuel E. Howell was born March 28, 1860, in Macon City, Mo. and died at the Wheatland hospital, Sunday, January 19, following an extended illness at the age of 86.

He was a retired farmer, homesteading 16 miles southwest of Wheatland in 1907 and had been a resident of Platte County since 1899. But since 1940, he had made his home with his niece, Miss Mamie Howell.

Mr. Howell was affiliated with the Methodist church.

Surviving are two brothers, J.A. Howell of Liberty, Mo., and Charles of Fort Madison, Iowa, five nephews, Harlon, Sam L. and Chester of Wheatland, Lester of Emmett, Idaho, and Riley of Great Falls, Mont., two nieces, Miss Mamie Howell of Wheatland and Mrs. Minnie Scott of Morerly, Mo.

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, January 21, at 2 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel, Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiating.
