

Samuel Howell Long-Time Ranche Dies October 29

Samuel Lee Howell, age 71, passed away in a local hospital Saturday, October 29, following long illness. He had ranched southwest of Wheatland for more than 50 years, having come to Wheatland when he was 18 years of age from Missouri where he was born August 15, 1884. He was preceded in death by Mrs. Howell who died here several years ago.

Funeral services for the deceased were held Tuesday of this week at 2 p. m., at the Schrader chapel with Mr. Floyd Hopper, minister of the Christian church, officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Pallbearers were James Irvin Sr., Tom Tugman, Phil Rietz, Samuel Mitchell, Paul Eshom and Robert Newkirk.

Survivors include four brothers: Chester J. of Cheyenne; Riley of Great Falls, Mont.; Wendell of Kansas City, Mo., and Lester of Garden City, Ida. A cousin, Mam Howell, resides in Wheatland.
