

HUBBARD, JENT FENTON

1870-December 6, 1913

Mr. Jent F. Hubbard, who recently underwent an operation for abscess, passed away in this city, on last Friday afternoon, December 5<sup>th</sup>, after an illness of several weeks duration.

Jent F. Hubbard was born in Malta, De Kalb County, Illinois, being 43 years, 9 months and 10 days of age at the time of his death. He was united in marriage to Mrs. Lovinia Stokoe, at Cheyenne, on September 6<sup>th</sup>, 1910, who, with a child of about two years of age, survive him. The deceased is a son of A.C. Hubbard of Wheatland, and is also survived by two brothers, John B. Hubbard and Fay W. Hubbard, both of Glendo.

The deceased was one of the prominent and prosperous ranchmen of Platte county, having a fine ranch on Bear Creek, near Glendo, where he lived for a number of years. He was a good neighbor, a kind and loving husband and father, and his many friends throughout this section, will be grieved to learn of his untimely demise. The bereaved family and relatives have the heartfelt sympathy of the entire community in their affliction.

The funeral was held from the First M.E. church, on Sunday afternoon, being conducted by Rev. J.K. Hicks, and despite the inclement weather, was attended by a large number of friends of the family. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
