Graveside services for Nellie Berniece "Bunny" Hubbard, 89, will be held today (Wednesday) at 2 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery, with Rev. Susan D. Pniifer of the United Methodist Church officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Hubbard died Monday, Jan. 8 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home in Wheatland.

She was born Oct. 5, 1900 at Mattoon, Ill., the daughter of Joseph and Lulu (Hart) Hart. She was reared and educated in Illinois. She was married to her high school sweetheart, Carl Clifford "Dutch" Hubbard in Brockton, Mass., in 1920.

They moved to Omaha, Neb., where Mr. Hubbard taught high school for 27 years. In 1947, the couple moved to Wheatland and built the dance hall at Hubbard's Mountain Cupboard, which they operated until 1975. They retired to Wheatland where they lived, until they moved to Laramie in 1981. Mrs. Hubbard had resided at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home since 1982. Her husband preceded her in death June 24, 1982.

She is survived by her two sons, Clifford Hubbard of Cheyenne, and Gerald Hubbard of Kansas City, Mo. Three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren also survive. She was also preceded in death by her parents and four sisters.
