NEWS ITEM August 2, 1934-Miss Dorothy Hudson, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Elvin Hudson of Antelope Gap, who has been seriously ill for the past ten days with a baffling malady, was last Saturday moved to the Wheatland Hospital clinic where an examination revealed the fact she was suffering from the most severe form of infantile paralysis. The disease had extended to the upper portion of the spinal cord, so that in addition to an almost complete paralysis of the muscles of her body and extremities, the muscles of the chest and throat had become involved until breathing and swallowing were more difficult. At the hospital it was stated that due to the impaired respiration, the oxygen machine is kept in immediate readiness. On account in the difficulty swallowing frozen articles only can be taken. It may be necessary to resort entirely to artificial methods of furnishing nourishment. Everyone in the community feels the deepest sympathy for this young woman and her family and her friends.
