September 10, 1889-March 12, 1965

Last rites for Elvin Hall Hudson, well-known rancher, were conducted by Rev. Clifford Polson at the Methodist Church on March 15, 1965 at 2:00 p.m. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Born in Palasade, Nebr. on Sept. 10, 1889, death occurred in the Platte County Memorial hospital on March 12, after an illness of short duration. Mr. Hudson, who had resided in this area since infancy was a member of the Methodist church, the Antelope Gap Grange and the Laramie Peak Stock Growers.
