

HUDSON, JAMES E.
December 2, 1862-February 15, 1926

James E. Hudson, resident of this community for almost thirty years, died Monday, February 15, at the home of his brother, Noah Hudson, on the lower Laramie at the age of 63 years, after an illness of several months.

Mr. Hudson was born in Indiana on December 2, 1862. At the age of five years he moved with his parents to Illinois and later to Indianola, Nebr. In 1879 he moved to Wheatland and had lived here since.

Familiarly known as "Uncle Jimmy", he was known and liked by all. He was a member of the local Methodist church and for many years, a regular attendant.

Having never married, he left no immediate family. Surviving him are two brothers, Noah Hudson and J.A.W. Hudson, the only near relatives known.
