

HUDSON, JOSEPH A.W.
August 15, 1857-June 12, 1943

J.A.W. Hudson, age 85, and a resident of Platte county for 47 years, died in St. Joseph's hospital in Denver, Saturday, June 13, death coming after a long illness. Mr. Hudson who was born in Blackford county, Ind., was a retired farmer.
