

HUFF, ANDREW JACKSON  
November, 1849-December 24, 1928

Andrew J. Huff died at Evanston, Wyo. Dec. 24<sup>th</sup>, from the flu and pneumonia. The funeral was held from Watson's Mortuary chapel Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.

Andrew Jackson Huff was born at Salem, Washington Co., Ind. Nov., 1849, and departed this life at Evanston, Wyo. Dec. 24<sup>th</sup>, 1928, aged 79 years, 1 month and 12 days. In his early years, he united with the M.E. church and was an active worker for many years. He went to Taswell County, Ill. when a young man. Here he was united in marriage to Cecelia Francis Carr. To this union were born nine children, all of whom were present at his funeral.
