

HUFF, MYRTLE VIOLA DUFFORD
February 7, 1898-November 30, 1928

The many friends of Mrs. Harree I. Huff were grieved to learn of her death on Friday, November 30th, at her home near Torrington. Funeral services were held from the Wheatland Baptist church, Sunday afternoon, with Rev. Chas. F. Thomas preaching the funeral oration. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge.
