Funeral services for Maynard Halbert Huffer, 1409 15<sup>th</sup> St., who passed away at his home Friday, Aug. 2, following an extended illness, were held Tues., Aug. 6, from the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Elmer Reuscher officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Huffer, a retired farmer, was born in Nebraska City, Nebr., Dec. 9, 1890, and had been a resident of this area for 20 years.
