

HUFFMAN, THOMAS A.

August 15, 1848-November 12, 1912

Thomas A. Huffman, one of the most highly respected citizens of Wheatland, passed away on Wednesday morning at his home, after an illness of several weeks duration, the immediate cause of death being heart trouble. The deceased had not been in the best of health for several months, but the news of his death will come as a surprise to his many friends throughout the section as his condition was not generally considered serious.

Thomas A. Huffman was born at Napanee, Ontario, on August 15, 1848, being 65 years, 2 months and 27 days at the time of his death. At the age of 14 years, he entered the drug business in his home town and was engaged in the business all his life. He left Napanee four years ago and moved to Wheatland, since which time he has held the position of pharmacist in the Pioneer Pharmacy.

The deceased is survived by a wife and three small children, two boys and a girl. Dr. F.G. Huffman, proprietor of Pioneer Pharmacy, is a son of the deceased, while another son Geo. Huffman, died at this place eight years ago last summer.

Mr. Huffman was one of the most honorable and upright gentlemen it has ever been our pleasure to meet, and his death leaves a void in the business circles of Wheatland that will never be filled. He was a true Christian, a kind and loving husband and father, and a person who always had a good word to say for every acquaintance.

Funeral services will be held next Sunday, November 16th, at two o'clock, from the residence of Dr. Huffman, and interment will take place in the Wheatland cemetery.
