December 28, 1898-March 8, 1969

Magda Bothen Hunton, a former resident of Wheatland, passed away Sunday, March 8, in Cheyenne after an illness of several weeks.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, March 11, at 11:00 a.m. in the All Saints Episcopal Church, Wheatland, with the Rev. James E. More officiating and interment in the local cemetery.
