

HUSTON, CLAYTON CORIDAN
November 14, 1892-September 25, 1967

Clayton Coridan Huston of Denver, former Platte County resident, succumbed suddenly Monday, Sept. 25, at Colorado Springs while on a business trip. Mr. Huston was born in Memphis, Mo., Nov. 14, 1892 and came to the Slater area in 1916. He retired from farming in 1958, and been a resident of Denver for the past several years, where he was engaged in various business enterprises.

Surviving are his wife, Eva M. Huston, Denver; three sons, Robert Huston, Slater; Gerald Huston, Las Vegas, Nev., and Wayne Huston; one daughter, Mrs. L.F.
