



Eva Grace Huston

Funeral services for ⁶⁻¹¹⁻¹⁹⁹² Eva Grace Huston, age 101 were held Monday, June 15, 1992 at 10 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Pastor Paul Decker of the Church of the Nazarene officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Eva Grace Huston died Thursday, June 11 at her home in Palisade, Colo., following a short illness.

She was born Dec. 25, 1890 in Welda, Kans., the daughter of Oliver Taylor and Sarah Eva (Southern Ashenhurst). At the age of six she left Kansas with her parents in a covered wagon and settled in Iowa. She was reared and educated in Iowa.

She taught school for several years in Iowa, and was then married to C.C. Huston in 1915 in Tingley, Iowa. They moved to Bordeaux, Wyo., in 1916, and she resided in the Wheatland area until 1988 at which time she moved to Palisade. She was a charter member of the Church of the Nazarene in Wheatland.

She is survived by three children, Nina Burns of Palisade, Colo., Robert Huston of Cheyenne, and Gera Huston of Las Vegas, Nev. Eight grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and seven great-great-grandchildren also remain.

She was preceded in death by her parents, two sons, Billy Huston and Wayne Huston, three sisters, four brothers, and one grandson, Greg Huston.

Serving as pallbearers were Bill Huston, Sid Jenkins, Warren Alloway, Jim Collins, Junior Edmiston and John Baker.
