

HUTCHINSON, DOYLE REUBEN

May 20, 1906-January 21, 1987

Services for Doyle R. Hutchinson, 79, who died in Cheyenne Jan. 21, 1987, were held in Wheatland at the United Methodist Church on Jan. 24 with Father Kale King officiating.

Doyle Hutchinson was born in Naponee, Neb. May 20, 1906, the son of Leonard and Amelia (James) Hutchinson. He was reared and educated in Nebraska and upon completion of his education served his apprenticeship with a funeral home and received his Nebraska Funeral Director's license. In 1935 he came to Wheatland and operated Bill's Shoe & Harness Shop. He served as County Coroner for 2 terms and was appointed County Assessor in 1945. He served in that capacity until retirement in 1982. He and his surviving wife, Ruth, were married in Wheatland, March 21, 1964.

He was a member of All Saints' Episcopal Church, Wheatland Lodge AF & AM, having served as Grand Master, Wheatland OES, having served as Worthy Patron, Korein Shrine of Rawlins. During his years in Wheatland he was very active in many civic, youth and political activities.

Besides his wife he is survived by two sons: Dennis Hutchinson of San Jose, Calif., George Hutchinson of Portland, Ore.; three daughters: Janice LaFollette of Colorado Springs, Colo., Ann O'Brien of Denver, Marjorie Gonzales of Jal, New Mexico; two step-children, Kenneth and Virginia Boyd both of Wheatland; three brothers: Calvin Hutchinson of Boise, Idaho, Robert Hutchinson of Aladdin, Wyo., Bill Hutchinson of San Antonio, Tex.; one sister Elosia Cooper of Denver, seventeen grandchildren and numerous great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, infant twin sisters, and his first wife, Inez.

A memorial has been established to All Saints Episcopal Church.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
