

HYATT, HARLEY C.

?-October 11, 1924

Harley C. Hyatt, 25 year-old World War Veteran of Soap Lake, Washington, died at 11 a.m. at the Commercial hotel as a result of heart trouble, having arrived here two days previously to try the climate here.

Mr. Hyatt was accompanied by his 16 year old bride, to whom he was married on June 25 of the present year. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy April 16, 1917, at the beginning of the World War and served three years, part of the term being spent at the naval training station at New Orleans, and part in active service on the battle ship Ohio. Recently he had been operating an ice cream parlor at Soap Lake, near Spokane. His illness took a serious turn two weeks ago, and he was advised by friends to try this climate. A week before starting, his wife met Mrs. James Miller, who was then visiting relatives in that section of Washington.
