

HYTREK, JOSEPH J.
March 7, 1882-July 13, 1943

Funeral mass was conducted last Friday morning at the Glendo church for Joseph Hytrek of Glendo, who passed away July 13 at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Ivan Gore in Douglas. Death came after an extended illness.

Mr. Hytrek, who was born in 1882 in Platte county, Nebraska, came to Wyoming in July, 1915, homesteading near Glendo, where he resided since that time.

Surviving are his wife, the former Gertrude Schumer of Hope, Kan., four children, Mrs. Gore of Douglas, Miss Josephine of Denver, Lawrence of Guernsey, and Fred of Glendo; four sisters, Mrs. E.P. Murphy of Stuart, Nebr., Mrs. A.W. Vogt, of Lincoln, Nebr., Rose Roschka of Stevens Point, Wis., and Mrs. E.L. Stroda of Abilene, Kan.; three brothers, George of Stuart, and William and Stencil of Glendo. Another brother, John, preceded him in death in 1942.
