

Grayrocks Woman Passes, Buried Wed.

Mrs. James Jeffers, 77-year old pioneer of the Greyrocks community, passed away at her home Wednesday afternoon. She had been in very poor health for some time previous to her demise.

Mrs. Jeffers was born at Sheboygan, Wis., August 26, 1856. She and her husband first came to Wyoming in 1907 and settled in the Albion community. Later in 1915 they moved to the Greyrocks community and have lived there since that time. Previous to their coming to Wyoming they resided in various parts of Iowa.

Mr. and Mrs. Jeffers were married on February 16, 1879 at Luther, Iowa.

Funeral services are being held this afternoon from the Lyla Watson Funeral Home. Rev. Claude L. Morton of Guernsey will deliver the funeral sermon. Interment will take place in the Wheatland cemetery.
