Dr. Gary Johnson, 55, a prominent Checotah Veterinarian died unexpectedly Thursday, September 11, 2008. He was born on Wednesday, December 17, 1952 on a small ranch in Wheatland, Wyoming to Pete and Mildred Cobb Johnson.

Gary grew up in Wheatland where he received his education, graduating from Wheatland High School. After graduation, he attended the University of Wyoming, in Laramie where he received his B.S. in Animal Science. Dr. Johnson received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine from Kansas State University in 1979.

While in Kansas, he met, fell in love and later married Gayle Davis on Saturday, August 12, 1978 in Jetmore, Kansas. After graduation, they moved to Checotah where Dr. Johnson established his Veterinary practice, where he faithfully served all of McIntosh County and surrounding areas until his death.

Dr. Johnson was a wonderful husband, exceptional father, always putting his family first, a great friend, and he never met a stranger. He enjoyed his cows, playing tennis, golf, hunting and boating.
